Beekeeper's Soap with beeswax, honey and propolis

Weigh all ingredients.

600 g olive oil 600 g palm oil 400 g coconut oil 400 g sweet almond oil 60 g beeswax grated propolis

480 g water 280 g NaOH

60 g honey 150 g water

Optional:

Essential oils, ground oatmeal or lavender, colorants, more!

- 1. Combine honey and water some hours before you want to start to be sure the honey is well combined and the mixture is room temperature.
- 2. Combine water with NaOH and set aside to cool.
- 3. Melt palm oil, coconut oil and beeswax together and stir to mix well
- 4. Add olive oil and sweet almond oil to warm oils
- 5. When oils and NaOH-water both reach 38-40°C combine them and stir constantly to light trace
- 6. At light trace, add honey-water and propolis and continue to stir to full trace.
- 7. Pour soap into prepared molds and insulate them while they cool.
- 8. Unmold soap after 20 hours. Soap may be sliced after a few days and should be cured for 6 weeks.
